Pathology Discussion: Dr. Asit Ranjan Mridha

A 20-year-old male presented to the Surgical Oncology Outpatient Department at AIIMS with complaints of pain and swelling over the upper back for two months.

He was apparently well till two months prior to presentation, when he noticed a swelling over his left scapular region, which was initially painless but started having dull aching pain over the lesion as the lesion grew in size. The pain was relieved by taking oral analgesics.

There was no history of similar swellings elsewhere in the body. There was no history of fever, weight loss, or loss of appetite. There was no history of cough, chest pain, or hemoptysis.

Medical History:

There was no associated co-morbidity.

Surgical History:

There was no previous operative history.

Personal History:

There was no high-risk behavior for malignancy

Family History:

There was no Family history of cancer

On Examination: There was a 15 \times 10 cm mass in the left scapular region, which was firm, non-tender, with a smooth surface. It was extending medially till 4 cm from the midline.
