National Space Day Celebrations 2024 @ SCTIMST - A Report

India made history on 23rd August 2023, with the successful soft landing of the Vikram lander as part of the Chandrayan - 3 mission and became the 4th country in the world to land a spacecraft on the moon. It is the first country to land a spacecraft on the south pole of the moon. To celebrate this landmark achievement, Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi announced August 23 as "National Space Day". The theme of the maiden National Space Day celebrated on August 23, 2024, was 'Touching Lives while Touching the Moon: India's Space Saga.'

Sree Chitra Tirunal Institute for Medical Sciences and Technology, Trivandrum, celebrated National Space Day on 23 Aug 2024. 


Photo: Full sequence of the Lunar Eclipse










